- * H.R. 3288 originally was the Transportation-Housing and Urban Development (HUD) appropriations bill. Four other appropriations bills were packaged with it for final passage as the FY2010 Consolidated Appropriations Act, including the Commerce-Justice-Science appropriations bill. The final version of the bill, report language and associated documents are posted on the House Appropriations Committee's <u>website</u>.
- **The Satellite Home Viewer Act regulates certain aspects of the home reception of television signals via satellite dishes. It involves both copyright law and telecommunications law and must be reauthorized every 5 years. After a tortuous course, Congress finally passed the newest version of the law the Satellite Television Extension and Localism Act (S. 3333) and it was signed into law on May 27, 2010. Previous bill numbers are: H.R. 2994/H.R. 3570/ S. 1670/ S. 2764. It is these bills to which the actions in the table refer. The law was temporarily extended in P.L. 111-118 (H.R. 3326).
- † In lieu of a conference report, each chamber can iterate the bill by sending it back and forth and ultimately pass the same version. For a brief explanation of congressional processes, see our What's a Markup? Fact Sheet, Step. 10 in particular.
- ††When agreement did not seem possible on the earlier versions of the FY2010 intelligence authorization bill, the Senate passed this one. Later, however, it went back and passed an amended version of the House bill.
- + House Science and Technology Committee chairman Bart Gordon released a <u>significantly revised version</u> of the bill on September 23, 2010, but subsequently <u>decided</u> to have the House vote on the Senate version of the bill.

Committees of Jurisdiction (see their websites or <u>Thomas</u> for more detailed information on legislative action).

- DOD Authorization: <u>House Armed Services Committee</u>, <u>Senate Armed Services Committee</u>. In both cases, the Strategic Forces Subcommittee has jurisdiction over most space programs.
- DOD Appropriations: <u>House Appropriations Committee</u>, <u>Senate Appropriations Committee</u>. In both cases, the Defense Subcommittee has jurisdiction over most space programs.
- DOE (Energy and Water Development) Appropriations: <u>House Appropriations Committee</u>, <u>Senate Appropriations Committee</u>. In both cases, the Energy and Water Development Subcommittee has jurisdiction over the Department of Energy (DOE). DOE produces radioisotope power systems used by NASA for certain space science missions and provides the plutonium-238 fuel for them. It also cooperates with NASA on certain high energy physics missions such as FERMI (formerly GLAST) and the Joint Dark Energy Mission (JDEM).

- NASA Authorization: House Science and Technology Committee; Senate Commerce, Science and Transportation Committee. The House S&T Subcommittee on Space and Aeronautics and the Senate Commerce Subcommittee on Science and Space have jurisdiction over NASA programs. (The House S&T Subcommittee on Research and Science Education and the Senate Subcommittee on Science and Space have jurisdiction over NSF. The House S&T Subcommittee on Energy and Environment and the Senate Commerce Subcommittee on Oceans, Atmosphere, Fisheries and Coast Guard have jurisdiction over NOAA.)
- NASA Appropriations: <u>House Appropriations Committee</u>, <u>Senate Appropriations Committee</u>. In both cases, the Commerce, Justice, Science (CJS) Subcommittee has jurisdiction over NASA programs (as well as NOAA and NSF).
- Intelligence Authorization: <u>House Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence</u>, <u>Senate Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence</u>. (Appropriations for the Intelligence Community are included in the DOD appropriations measure.)
- The <u>Satellite Home Viewer Extension and Reauthorization Act</u> regulates certain aspects of satellite television and must be reauthorized every 5 years. It affects both telecommunications law and copyright law and thus is within the jurisdiction of the <u>House Energy and Commerce</u> (E&C) Committee and the <u>House Judiciary</u> (Jud) Committee, and the <u>Senate Commerce</u>, <u>Science and Transportation</u> (Comm) Committee and the <u>Senate Judiciary</u> (Jud) Committee.
- Creating a New U.S. Code Title For Space-Related Laws. House Judiciary Committee; Senate Judiciary Committee.
- Third Party Liability Indemnification for Commercial Launch Companies: <u>House Science and Technology Committee</u>; <u>Senate Commerce, Science and Transportation Committee</u>.

Commercial Space Transportation Centers of Excellence: House Science and Technology Committee
