Note 1: H.R. 3547 originally was a bill to extend third party liability indemnification for commercial launch services companies. It passed the House approving a one-year extension. The Senate amended it to a three-year extension and returned the bill to the House. There, it was transformed into the FY2014 Omnibus Appropriations Act (or Consolidated Appropriations Act) funding the government for the rest of FY2014 as well as extending indemnification. The Omnibus incorporates all the 12 regular FY2014 appropriations bills, including Defense, CJS, and T-HUD. The bill and accompanying explanatory statements are posted on the House Rules Committee website; NASA and NOAA are in Division B. The explanatory statement is separated into several sections on the Rules Committee's website. Division B is part of the section entitled "Front Matter – Division B." DOD is Division C. Transportation (including FAA) is Division L.

Note 2: The Senate debated the Motion to Proceed to Consideration of H.R. 4660, the House-passed version of the CJS appropriations bill over several days during the weeks of June 9 and 16, 2014. The Senate Appropriations Committee planned to introduce an amendment in the nature of the substitute with the texts of three bills – CJS, T-HUD and Agriculture – to create a "minibus" appropriations bill. However, agreement could not be reached on the amendment process, as explained in this SpacePolicyOnline.com article, and action on the bill stalled. Ultimately, these were among the bills included in the "cromnibus," H.R. 83 (see note 5).

Note 3: The House passed H. R. 4412, the 2014 NASA Authorization Act, on June 9, 2014. However, some sort of error occurred in the engrossment process and the House sent the Senate the wrong version of the bill. It then requested the Senate to return the bill, which it did on June 19, 2014 (the Commerce Committee was discharged from further consideration of the bill and the Senate agreed to the request of the House for the return of the papers with respect to H.R. 4412). On June 20, 2014, the House agreed to a unanimous consent request by Rep. Steve Palazzo (R-MS), without objection, to engross the correct version of the bill.

Note 4: The House and Senate Intelligence Committees each reported FY2014 Intelligence Authorization bills in November 2013 (H.R. 3381/S. 1681). There was no further action until May 2014 when the House passed a revised bill (H.R. 4681) that covered both FY2014 and FY2015. The Senate, however, did not follow suit and in June 2014 instead passed an amended version of its original bill, S. 1681 covering only FY2014. The House agreed to that bill and it became law in July 2014 (P.L. 113-120). The Senate committee then introduced and reported a new bill for FY2015 (S. 2741). The House and Senate committees reached a compromise on a FY2015 bill using the H.R. 4681 bill number. The Senate passed the compromise version as an amendment to H.R. 4681 on December 9 and then the House agreed to the amended version on December 10, 2014.

Note 5: The "cromnibus" is a combination of a short-term (through Feb. 27, 2015) Continuing Resolution (CR) for the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) and a full-year (through the end of FY2015 on September 30, 2015) omnibus appropriations for all other departments and agencies funded by the regular appropriations bills. "Omnibus" bills combine several individual appropriations bills into one to expedite congressional consideration. In this case, the omnibus combines 11 of the 12 regular appropriations bills – all except DHS – including the Commerce-Justice-Science bill that funds NASA and NOAA (Division B), and the defense bill (Division D). The official title of this bill is the Consolidated and Further Continuing Appropriations Act, 2015. The final version of the bill is posted on GPO's website. The accompanying joint explanatory statement was published in the Congressional Record on December 11, 2014.

* For the FY2013 Consolidated and Further Continuing Appropriation Act (P.L. 113-6), the House published an explanatory statement in the March 6, 2013 Congressional Record beginning at page H1029 and the Senate published an explanatory statement in the March 11, 2013 Congressional Record beginning on page S1287.

** This CR reopened the government after a 16 day shutdown (October 1-16, 2013), raised the debt limit, and funds the government through January 15, 2014. The text of H.R. 2775 as originally passed by the House was replaced by new text. As amended, the title of the bill is the Continuing Appropriations Act, 2014. The text is on the Senate Appropriations Committee's website.

† H.R. 3304 originally concerned awarding Medals of Honor to certain individuals. It was used as a vehicle for a <u>compromise version</u> of the National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) agreed to by the House and Senate Armed Services Committees on December 9, 2013. The House adopted the amended version on December 12, 2013, the Senate on December 19, 2013.

- Defense Appropriations: <u>House Appropriations Committee</u>, <u>Senate Appropriations Committee</u>. The Defense Subcommittee has jurisdiction over most space programs.
- FAA Office of Commercial Space Transportation authorization: <u>House Science, Space and Technology Committee</u>; <u>Senate Commerce, Science and Transportation Committee</u>.
- FAA Office of Commercial Space Transportation appropriations: <u>House Appropriations Committee</u>, <u>Senate Appropriations</u>

 <u>Committee</u>. The Transportation-Housing and Urban Development (T-HUD) Subcommittee has jurisdiction over FAA, of which the Office of Commercial Space Transportation is part.
- Intelligence Authorization: <u>House Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence</u>, <u>Senate Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence</u>. (Appropriations for the Intelligence Community are included in the defense appropriations bill.)
- NASA Authorization: <u>House Science, Space and Technology Committee</u>; <u>Senate Commerce, Science and Transportation Committee</u>. The House SS&T Subcommittee on Space and the Senate Commerce Subcommittee on Science and Space have jurisdiction over NASA programs. The House SS&T Subcommittee on Energy and Environment and the Senate Commerce Subcommittee on Oceans, Atmosphere, Fisheries and Coast Guard have jurisdiction over NOAA.
- NASA Appropriations: <u>House Appropriations Committee</u>, <u>Senate Appropriations Committee</u>. The Commerce, Justice, Science (CJS) Subcommittee has jurisdiction over NASA programs.
- NOAA Appropriations: <u>House Appropriations Committee</u>, <u>Senate Appropriations Committee</u>. The Commerce, Justice, Science (CJS) Subcommittee has jurisdiction over NOAA, which is part of the Department of Commerce.
