This is not a comprehensive list. It shows selected bills on which action appears likely or otherwise are of special interest. Historical versions of this fact sheet are available on SpacePolicyOnline.com for the 111th, 112th, 113th, 114th, 115th, 116th, and 117th Congresses. Congresses begin on January 3 every other year so the 111th Congress, for example, was January 3, 2009-January 3, 2011. The others were 2011-2013, 2013-2015, 2015-2017, 2017-2019, 2019-2021, and 2021-2023 respectively.

"Ord. Rpt." means the bill was "ordered reported" from the committee -- the committee approved it and ordered that it be reported to the House or Senate, but the report has not been filed yet, so there is no report number. "Skld" – scheduled. N/A – no action or not applicable. NDAA = National Defense Authorization Act. E&C = House Energy and Commerce Committee.

* H.R. 5617 would extend the "learning period" during which the FAA cannot promulgate additional commercial human spaceflight regulations for another 8 years, to September 30, 2031. The existing prohibition would have expired on September 30, 2023 and action on this bill had not occurred, so Congress included a 3-month extension to January 1, 2024 in the FY2024 Continuing Resolution, **H.R 5860**, that passed that day. **H.R. 6503** extended it again, to March 9, 2024. **H.R. 7454** would extend it yet again to May 11, 2024.

** Speaker Johnson's "laddered" CR had two different expiration dates. Four bills (Agriculture, Energy-Water, MilCon-VA and THUD) would expire on January 19, 2024 and the other eight on February 2, 2024. Congress extended those dates to March 1 and March 8 respectively in a third FY2024 CR using H.R. 2872 as the legislative vehicle (introduced as the Permanent Electronic Duck Stamp Act related to migratory bird hunting and conservation). Congress passed a fourth FY2024 CR extending the dates to March 8 and March 22 although there now are two sets of six bills.

† The first FY2024 "minibus" of six appropriations bills passed the House on March 6 using H.R. 4366 as the legislative vehicle, which was the original MilCon-VA bill. The final version bundles Agriculture, Commerce-Justice-Science (incl NASA and NOAA), Energy-Water, Interior, Milcon-VA, and Transportation-HUD (incl the FAA).

- DOD Authorization: <u>House Armed Services Committee</u>, <u>Senate Armed Services Committee</u>. The Strategic Forces Subcommittee has jurisdiction over most space programs.
- Defense Appropriations: <u>House Appropriations Committee</u>, <u>Senate Appropriations Committee</u>. The Defense Subcommittee has jurisdiction over most space programs.
- FAA Office of Commercial Space Transportation authorization: <u>House Science, Space and Technology Committee</u>; <u>Senate Commerce, Science and Transportation Committee</u>.
- FAA Office of Commercial Space Transportation appropriations: <u>House Appropriations Committee</u>, <u>Senate Appropriations</u>

 <u>Committee</u>. The Transportation-Housing and Urban Development (T-HUD) Subcommittee has jurisdiction over FAA, of which the Office of Commercial Space Transportation is part.

- Federal Communications Commission (FCC) authorization: <u>House Energy and Commerce Committee</u>; <u>Senate Commerce</u>, <u>Science</u>, and <u>Transportation Committee</u> (bills related to satellite spectrum)
- FCC Appropriations: <u>House Appropriations Committee</u>, <u>Senate Appropriations Committee</u>. The Financial Services and General Government subcommittee has jurisdiction over the FCC.
- Intelligence Authorization: <u>House Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence</u>, <u>Senate Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence</u>. (Appropriations for the Intelligence Community are included in the defense appropriations bill.)
- NASA Authorization: <u>House Science, Space and Technology Committee</u>; <u>Senate Commerce, Science and Transportation Committee</u>. The House SS&T Subcommittee on Space and Aeronautics, and the Senate Commerce Subcommittee on Space and Science have jurisdiction over NASA. The House SS&T Subcommittee on Environment and the Senate Commerce Subcommittee on Oceans, Fisheries, Climate Change and Manufacturing have jurisdiction over NOAA.
- NASA Appropriations. <u>House Appropriations Committee</u>, <u>Senate Appropriations Committee</u>. The Commerce, Justice, Science (CJS) subcommittee has jurisdiction over NASA programs.
- NOAA Appropriations: <u>House Appropriations Committee</u>, <u>Senate Appropriations Committee</u>. The Commerce, Justice, Science (CJS) Subcommittee has jurisdiction over NOAA, which is part of the Department of Commerce.
